Impression Protocol

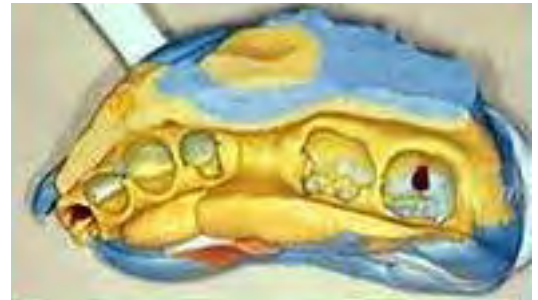
GOOD TRIPLE TRAY

- Single or Double Units
- Evaluate tori, bony exostosis, third molars, or cross bites that can compromise accuracy, please add bite registration if needed
- Contraindications for Double Bite Impression
 - More than 2 restorations
 - Fixed partial denture
 - Crown is to be used as an abutment for RPD
 - Patient cannot close with tray in mouth



BETTER QUADRANT + ALIGNATE OPPOSING + BITE

- Single or Double Units
- Up to 3 unit bridges
- Implants
- A bite registration including the preparation site and at least two of the adjacent teeth is invaluable for proper model articulation



BEST FULL ARCH + POLYVINYL OPPOSING + BITE

- Single or Double Units
- Three Unit + Bridge
- Nightguards
- Veneer
- Implants
- Alginate Opposing can be used for non-critical situations, i.e. nightguard opposing arch



SUPERIOR FULL ARCH + POLYVINYL OPPOSING + BITE + STUDY MODELS/WAX-UPS + DIGITAL PICTURES

- Full Mouth Restorations
- Large Cases
- Multiple unit anterior cases
